

2020 Aztalan Cycle Club New Membership Check List

✓ Application:

Completed and signed. Please be sure your email address is legible, as you will be informed via email that your paperwork has been received. Also, you will receive the Club Newsletter via email. Signing the application and signing the release are two completely different things. **Be sure to do both**.

Working members: Most new members will be assigned to MX flagging or the new member sampler package (4 days MX flagging, 1 day Grounds, 1 day MX food, 1 day Short Track). You may select whether it is first or second race day shift and you may make another choice. Be sure to check out the committee descriptions. MX events run the second Sunday of each month April through October. Short tracks events run the third Saturday of each month June through September with next day Sundays in July through Sept. Check the website for full dates and details. Your committee assignment will require seven different dates, with at least a five hour commitment. New working members will receive their cards and key from their committee head upon completion of their three work days.

✓ Aztalan Releases:

Every person listed under Family* Members names MUST have an Aztalan Club Release on file. Whether they race or ride, or even if they may never be at the track, as long as they are listed as family members, we need that release. According to the Club's bylaws, a family member is defined as: Spouse or significant other, and dependent children under the age of 18.

- > Each family member **must sign** his or her own release.
- Each minor above age four MUST print their name (for little ones) or sign in the appropriate spot.
- Should your child be older than 18 but fully dependent on you, (e.g. a student, or a child with a handicap), please advise the committee by completing the 5 Xi `h8 YdYbXYbIg'5 [fYYa Ybhfor those with kids over 18.

All minor's releases must be **signed by the minor** and **parents and then notarized**. All minors should sign the upper line; both parents must sign on the lower line. This form must be notarized. If your minor is too young to sign, one parent should sign the child's name, then his/her own name with an indication of mother, father, or legal guardian. Then both parents sign at the lower spaces and have the release notarized.

PLEASE NOTE: As a member of Aztalan, there is no need for you to complete another release at any Aztalan event.

Check or Money Order:

\$435 for New Non-Working Club Members, and \$200 for New Working Members, payable to Aztalan Cycle Club, Inc. No cash please. Checks will be deposited within 14 days after being received. If your check is returned to us, you will be immediately notified. A cashier's check for the full amount plus bank charges must be returned to us within ten days of notification or your membership will be considered void.

At your local Post Office, send your paperwork as ERR certified mail. This allows you to electronically track the receipt of your application on your computer. Mail to:

Incomplete paperwork will be returned to you. You will have **ten** days in which to return it or you may lose your spot.

Non-Working Club & Renewing Working members may pick up their cards and keys at the Welcoming Day in Spring. New Working members will receive their cards and key from their committee head upon completion of their three work days. If that time is already in by the welcoming day, card and keys will be handed out then.
